Program Overview

PC&VS will serve adults who wish to be fully employed, adults that wish to be partially employed, and adults who chose not to work, but to remain active in their communities to any degree that they choose. Our day program will focus on empowerment, self-advocacy, and community integration. We will strive to increase opportunities and develop positive self-concepts for the individuals we will serve. We anticipate working with consumers from varying ethnic backgrounds and with varying disabilities (i.e., exceptionalities) and will embrace these differences. Our philosophy will focus on supporting the needs of the individuals we serve; building self-concept through activity and productivity and increasing opportunities and access to the community.

We offer:

- Psychological Support We will incorporate several aspects of counseling opportunities. These opportunities will focus on the appropriate way to interact with others (i.e., fellow day program attendees, staff and visitors who come into the program, and others in the community)
- Activities of Daily Living Support We will expect that clients will come to us with varying levels of skill with activities of daily living. Our program will teach/assist clients with cleaning, grocery shopping, budgeting skills and other ADL skills.
- Behavioral Support Our staff will utilize positive behavior support plans for our clients. The plans will be based on Functional Assessments of inappropriate behavior. The assessment will focus on determining the triggers, consequences, and functions of the inappropriate behavior and support the development of positive alternative behaviors.
